RE: Consultation on the proposal to relocate Supported Living Services to 519 Green Lanes, Good Mayes, IG3 1XL

Dear ,

We are consulting on the following proposal and seek your views:

- The relocation of services at 11 Gordon Road, Romford, RM6 6DD to 519 Green Lanes, Good Mayes, IG3 1XL.
- The relocation of services at 2 Montrose Avenue, Romford, RM2 6RH to 519 Green Lanes, Good Mayes, IG3 1XL.
- The relocation of services from 1A Water Lane, Ilford, IG3 9HE to 519 Green Lanes, Good Mayes, IG3 1XL.

When will this happen?

It is proposed that the Supported Living Services and accommodation will relocate between August and September 2018.

Rationale for the move

There is a need for more modern and spacious facilities for young adults with complex needs. The new premises will provide a new building, which will offer more modern spacious facilities for young adults and would enable us to provide improved outcomes for individuals with learning disabilities. There will be a high dependency wing which will enable those individuals with complex needs requiring care to be supported and cared for.

Would the provision change?

Should the proposal go ahead, the current staff teams will move to Good Mayes. The type of service will remain the same but with added features to support high dependency individuals requiring

care. There will also be increased capacity for up to 40 places in the Supported Living Services. The services will be registered with CQC for home care. A new Statement of Purpose, Location Risk Assessment and amendment to the current CQC will ensue in line with current regulations.



Further comments and observations processed, and final configurations and adjustments made. Update CQC Registration for Young Adults Service.	23 rd to 27 th July
Planned relocation services and clients.	Date to be advised depending on final preparations
